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Admission to Higher Year

A student become eligible for admission to higher year or for keeping terms thereof on the basis of passing or obtaining status as "Allowed to Keep Term (ATKT)" in the examination in which he/she has appeared, as shown in following table :

<i>Admission to Year</i>	<i>Eligibility</i>
Second Year	Pass / ATKT at Semester I and II combined.
Third Year	1. Pass in Semester I and II and 2. Pass / ATKT at Semester III and IV combined.

Rules for ATKT for admission to higher year

A candidate with ATKT become eligible for admission to next higher year as shown in following table :

Table deciding ATKT status for FIRST YEAR to SECOND YEAR

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Table deciding ATKT status for SECOND YEAR to THIRD YEAR

<i>Class & Course</i>	<i>Total Number of subjects (Sem. III & Sem. IV combined)</i>	<i>Minimum number of subjects required to be passed (Sem. III & Sem. IV combined)</i>	<i>Maximum number of failure subjects allowed for availing benefit of ATKT (Sem. III + Sem. IV combined)</i>

SYIF	14	10	4

NOTE :

1. A subject may have some or all of the following heads of passing, as prescribed in the teaching and examination scheme of the curriculum :

Theory, Practical, Termwork, Oral, Project and Seminar.

Each head have separate marks. However, for a theory subject, its prescribed passing heads shall not be treated as separate passing heads for the purpose of granting ATKT (meaning failure in any one of them shall be treated as failure in that subject.)

For example, Microprocessor & Programming (MAP) subject of CM4E and IF4E have two heads : THEORY and PRACTICAL. If student fails in MAP THEORY or MAP PRACTICAL OR BOTH MAP THEORY and PRACTICAL, then it is treated as failed in one subject.

2. Subject head without passing requirement is not considered as subject for the purpose of deciding ATKT status. **For example, Sessional (SW) is not considered as subject for deciding ATKT status.**
